

## HOW TO CALCULATE GPA IN CONROE ISD

- Convert each **semester** grade to the grade point equivalent according to the following chart.

Grade Range	Letter Grade	AP(P) DC (U)	Pre AP(Q) Honors(H)	Level Courses
90-100	A	6.0	5.0	4.0
80-89	B	5.0	4.0	3.0
75-79	C	4.0	3.0	2.0
70-74	D	3.0	2.0	1.0
Below 70	F	0	0	0

- Do this for each semester in high school.
- Average all the grade points: (Add all numbers in the yellow columns and divide by the total number of semester courses.)  
Example:  $(6 \times 2) + (5 \times 2) + (4 \times 12) = 70$ ; Total points =  $70/16 = 4.375$  GPA
- Please note the following exceptions:
  - Courses taken in junior high school **are not** calculated into GPA
  - Courses receiving Local Credit **are not** calculated into GPA
  - All summer school courses taken after 8<sup>th</sup> grade **are** calculated into GPA including the summer after 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
  - GPA Exempt courses are not calculated into GPA and are designated with an "O" on the transcript.
