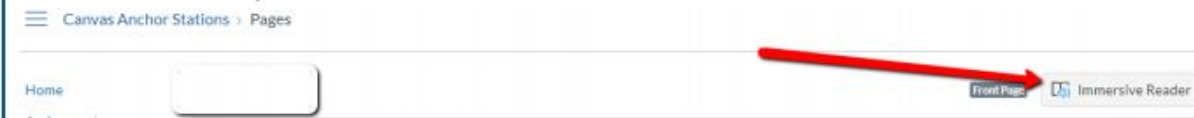


Canvas— Immersive Reader Student

You can now use Microsoft Immersive Reader to enhance your reading experience by improving accessibility and boosting reading comprehension.

You will see the Immersive Reader button when you are viewing a page. Click on the Immersive Reader button to open:



The Microsoft Immersive Reader displays a variety of tools and options to enhance your reading experience.

- [1] Toolbar allows you to manage text, grammar and reading preferences.
- [2] Full Screen button will allow you to expand the reader display.
- [3] Play button to start hearing the page text read aloud.
- [4] Voice Settings button allows you to adjust audio settings.
- [5] Exit button to close the reader and return to Canvas.
