

An important message about School Day SAT/PSAT:

Grand Oaks High School has scheduled a digital PSAT for Wednesday, October 23, 2024, for some 9th, all 10th, and all 11th-grade students. Additionally, the SAT will be offered at GOHS on Wednesday, October 23, 2024, for some 12th-grade students. The PSAT and SAT are college-readiness exams that showcase high school coursework content mastery. Many colleges and universities utilize scores from these exams (along with other factors) to determine college readiness. They are designed to measure a student's ability to understand and process academic subjects and have proven to indicate collegiate success. College-bound students are strongly suggested to take these tests since these scores can help determine merit-based scholarships; many local scholarships may also require score reporting.

The digital PSAT and SAT take about 3 hours to complete and have a built-in calculator (Desmos: [Click here for Calculator](#)). GOHS will **NOT** provide calculators for the PSAT or SAT though students may bring their own.

9th grade: PSAT for 9th grade is completely optional. GOHS recommends taking the PSAT only if you are a high-achieving Geometry Honors student or taking Algebra 2. You must register for the PSAT by paying \$15 through School Cash by September 15, 2024 at 11:59 PM; use the link below. **No late registrations will be accepted.**

10th and 11th grade: All students take the PSAT and are automatically registered.

12th grade:

>If you have **not** taken the SAT/ACT and would like to take the SAT on campus, you may take it for free; all students are allowed to take the SAT/ACT once for free by the state of Texas. If this applies to you, you should receive an e-mail regarding your eligibility. The best alternate option would be to take the TSIA in the Spring of 2024. You can speak with your counselor to help with this decision if needed. If you choose to take the SAT on October 23, you must register on this Google Form by September 15, 2024 at 11:59 PM. **No late registrations will be accepted.**

>If you took the SAT in March 2024 at GOHS or took the SAT/ACT on your own and received a reimbursement, you may take the SAT for a fee of \$42. To register for the SAT, you must pay through School Cash by September 15, 2024 at 11:59 PM. **No late registrations will be accepted.**
